



International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB) issued IFRS Sustainability Disclosure Standards




In June 2023, the International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB) issued the first two standards, IFRS S1 (General Requirements for Disclosure of Sustainability-related Financial Information Standard) and IFRS S2.

These Standards reflect the redeliberations of the ISSB, which were informed by extensive feedback from stakeholders and aim to establish a comprehensive global baseline of sustainability-related disclosures to meet the needs of capital markets.

More than US \$186 billion allocated to implement Saudi Green Initiative – His Excellency Mr. Adel Al-Jubeir

<u>April 24, 2024</u>

In Middle East and North Africa Climate Week 2023 on October 8, 2023, His Excellency Mr. Adel Al-Jubeir – Minister of State for Foreign Affairs and Saudi Climate Envoy said that more than \$186 billion has been allocated to implement the Saudi Green Initiative, which includes 77 initiatives. During a panel discussion on the first day of the Middle East and North Africa Climate Week 2023 in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, HE Mr. Adel Al-Jubeir explained that the initiatives implemented by Saudi Arabia are aimed to achieve its climate goals through designing cities in a way reducing congestion times so as to lead to less pollution. "If these initiatives save an hour per day for each person, they will save the equivalent of four years of his life when he reaches the age of 80," he said.

Saudi Arabia is committed to implementing sustainable development and attaches the highest priority to this endeavor, as commensurate with the Kingdom's specific context and national principles. The Saudi Exchange issued Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) disclosure guidelines to promote sustainable growth in Saudi Arabia on October 28, 2021. The guidelines demonstrate Saudi Exchange's continued commitment to support more than 200 listed companies and also prospective companies looking to list. These guidelines are intended to help companies listed on Saudi Exchange to: Increase awareness and understanding of what ESG is and why it is important.

Mr. Mohammed Al-Rumaih, CEO of the Saudi Exchange (Tadawul) said ""Publishing ESG disclosure guidelines marks a significant milestone in our efforts to provide a consistent approach to ESG reporting for all our listed companies."
